What do we know about MICAH?



1:1 Prophet "Micah of Moresheth".
1:14 "Moresheth Gath" South Judah.
→ Micah ministered during reigns of three of Judah's kings:

- Jotham (+ 16 years)
- Ahaz (- 16 years)
- Hezekiah (+ 29 years)

He foretold & saw the destruction of Samaria (722-721BC). 1:6

He also foretold the captivity of Judah into Babylon (586BC).

MICAH was contemporary with ISAIAH & HOSEA & AMOS.


1:1-2 Micah's Prophecy is from **THE LORD** & for:

→ Samaria (capital of the northern kingdom of Israel)

→ Jerusalem (capital of the southern kingdom of Judah)

➔ All of the Earth! This includes you & me...

GOD's JUSTICE DEMANDS PUNISHMENT Because of Israel's transgression and sin, The Holy God plans to destroy them...


HOPE

MICAH's WARNINGS OF JUDGEMENT

1:3-4 The Lord comes down to meet out Judgement: Trampling & Splitting... Fire – Burning & Melting... Water – Washing away & Drowning...

1:5-7 God's Punishment of SAMARIA & JUDAH: Because of their sin, transgression, idolatry, immorality...



MICAH's WARNINGS OF JUDGEMENT

1:8-16 Micah's response: to weep, to go barefoot, naked, to howl & moan, shave head in mourning...



WARNINGS about FALSE PROPHETS

2:6-11 These FALSE PROPHETS didn't prophesy painful warnings (v.6), nor warned of the Lord's anger (v.7), they winked at oppression (v.8), undermined marriage & family life (v.9), chased away true prophets (v.10), & prophesied indulgence of sinful passions (v.11) ...

→ // Some preachers & churches today?! → WATCH OUT!



GREEDY LEADERS AND PROPHETS

3:1-4 GREEDY LEADERS:
Don't "know" justice (v.1)
Hate good & love evil (v.2)
Devour the people (v.3)
→ God will hide from them,
because of the evil they've done.



3:5-7 MERCENARY PROPHETS: Lead the people astray & proclaim a pleasant message to those who pay them (v.5)
→ God will bring on them darkness, shame, disgrace...
They will receive no answer from God (v.6-7)

GREEDY LEADERS AND PROPHETS

For the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. **2 Timothy 4:3-4**



But there were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. They will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the sovereign Lord who bought them, bringing swift destruction on themselves. Many will follow their depraved conduct and will bring the way of truth into disrepute. In their greed these teachers will exploit you with fabricated stories. Their condemnation has long been hanging over them, and their destruction has not been sleeping. **2 Peter 2:1-3**

WARNING TO Rulers Priests Prophets

3:8-12 FAITHFUL MICAH: Calling out the Truth & God's Justice to Israel's Leaders, Rulers, Priests and Prophets... $3:12 \rightarrow$ Quoted in Jeremiah 26:18-19... (150 years later) "Micah of Moresheth prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah. He told all the people of Judah, 'This is what the Lord Almighty says: 'Zion will be plowed like a field, Jerusalem will become a heap of rubble, the temple hill a mound overgrown with thickets.' Did Hezekiah king of Judah or anyone else in Judah put him to death? Did not Hezekiah fear the Lord and seek his favor? And did not the Lord relent, so that he did not bring the disaster he pronounced against them? ..."

- → This led to repentance & revival in Judah!
- → God forgave & delivered them in the time of Hezekiah.

THE FUTURE KINGDOM ANNOUNCED

4:1-8 This Kingdom is for All Nations of the Earth, it is established in Jerusalem, built on God's Word & His Law & His ways, a Kingdom of Justice, Peace, Prosperity, that will never end. → God gathers the lame... the exiles... those who are grieving... the remnant... those driven away... you & me!



THE PROMISE OF THE MESSIAH

5:2-5 This future Ruler would be born in Bethlehem... He will shepherd the flock in the strength of the Lord... His greatness will reach to the ends of the earth... He will be

their peace...

This was fulfilled in **Jesus**, born 700 yrs later !




THE PROMISE OF THE MESSIAH


