What is our Response?

- → "Wail because the new wine has been snatched from our lips..." (= present happiness ceases) 1:5
- → "Mourn like a virgin in sackcloth grieving for the husband of her youth..." (= past joy has finished) 1:8
- → "Offerings are cut off... Priests are in mourning..."
 (= spiritual life is depressed) 1:9
- → "Despair as a farmer because the harvest of the field is destroyed..." (= prosperity has gone) 1:11
- → "The vine, fig tree, pomegranate, palm and apple tree are withered..." (= no future fruitfulness is left) 1:12a
- → "Surely the joy of mankind is withered away..."
- (= depression in all facets of life) 1:12b

Why does God allow Suffering & Tough Stuff to happen to His People?


(A) God calls us to Repent and Fast and Return to Him 1:13-14, 2:12-14.



(B) God wants us to Pray and Cry out to Him 2:15-23a.

"Gather the people, say 'spare your people O Lord'...

He will do great things..."

(C) God wants to Speak to us & Save us 2:28-32.

"I will pour out my Spirit on all people: Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams...

your young men will see visions ... I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth... And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Why does God allow Suffering & Tough Stuff to happen to His People?

(D) God prepares us for the final Day of the Lord 3:1-2, 12-16.

"I will gather all nations...

I will enter into judgement against them...

The Day of the Lord is near.

The Day of the Lord is near The Lord will be a refuge for His own people..."





"But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up."

Why does God allow Suffering & Tough Stuff to happen to His People?

(E) Ultimately, God wants to bless his people forever 2:25-27, 3:17-21.

"I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten, you will praise the Lord... Judah & Jerusalem will be

inhabited forever..."










... So WHY is God allowing Suffering and really Tough Circumstances to happen in YOUR life?
