
Farewell (5:12-14)

A "Fellow Elder" Exhorts Elders-and Others (5:1-5)

"Witness of **Christ's sufferings**, partaker in glory to be" Peter never forgot Christ's sufferings (x8 in all 5 chptrs) Their impact on him was always fresh, alive

Humility versus the Roaring Lion (5:6-11)

Humility: Toward Whom? What latter end?

Anxieties: Where do we dump them?

Shepherd ... Oversee: willingly ... eagerly ... exemplarily
