



Paul's Epistle to THE PHILIPPIANS...

- This letter was written by Paul from Rome, in 61AD, while under house arrest there for 2 years (Acts 28).
- Philippians mentions "joy" & "gladness" & "rejoice" many times – despite suffering & persecution!
- Christian JOY is not dependent on circumstances,
 but on Jesus and our life & relationship with Him...
- Some of the early believers there were: Lydia & her household, the healed slave-girl, the jailer & his family.





1:1-2 God's Grace and Peace is meant for all Believers



1:3-6 God will complete the work He began in our life








1:15-18 Paul rejoiced that Jesus was being preached, even by insincere greedy rivals... What is my attitude?






1:21-26 To Live is Christ... & to Die with Christ is gain!







Four STARS for us to imitate in Philippians chapter 2

1. Christ – perfect Humility & Sacrifice

2. Paul – a life Offered to God

3. Timothy — a Faithful Son & Servant

4. Epaphroditus – a Fellow Soldier & Worker

2:1-4 Unity and Fellowship: Vertical → Horizontal

- Are you United with Christ?
 (Comforted by His Love...)
- Do you have Fellowship with the Spirit? (Tenderness+Compassion)
- → Unity with **Fellow Believers**! (...be like-minded... have the same love... be united in spirit & purpose... not selfish ambition, nor vain conceit, but humble, putting others' interests above our own ones...)
- → This will result in our JOY being completed: For ourselves & for others in our lives...
- // John Piper's "Christian Hedonism" message:
- → Following Christ brings us the greatest JOY!

2:5-11 Become Like Jesus and Imitate His Attitude!



- → One of the greatest **Doxologies** in the Bible, and it is meant for a practical pastoral purpose!
- → Yes, it should inspire our **hearts** to worship, but especially should inspire our **lives** to change!


Seven steps of Humility that Jesus willingly took:

- 1. Didn't grasp or hold on to his rightful position
- 2. Made himself nothing
- 3. Took on the nature of a servant
- 4. Became a human being
- 5. Humbled himself
- 6. Obedient till death
- 7. Even death on a cross

Therefore God exalted Christ sevenfold:

- 1. God exalted Jesus to the highest place
- 2. Gave him the Name above every name
- 3. At the Name of Jesus every knee will bow
- 4. Everyone in Heaven will acknowledge Him
- 5. Everyone on Earth will acknowledge Him
- 6. Everyone under the Earth will acknowledge Him
- 7. Every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord
 - to the glory of God the Father

- → Does MY LIFE display the humility and sacrifice and love of Christ?
- → When others see MY LIFE, are they attracted to the example of Jesus?






- Obey God's Word: whether in public or in private...

 - → Rejoicing!!!




2:19-30 Timothy & Epaphroditus: 2 Great Examples!



TIMOTHY:

- 1. Cheered people up
- 2. Took a genuine interest in their welfare
- 3. Looked for the interests of Christ above his own
- 4. Proved himself as a son with his father
- 5. Served in the work of the gospel


→ Is this what I am like also?



EPAPHRODITUS:

- 1. Paul called him: My Brother, Fellow Worker, Fellow Soldier, a Reliable Messenger...
- He was faithful in severe sickness, he almost died for the work of Christ...
- 3. Brought gladness & joy to those he visited & left behind...

→ Is this what my life looks like too?
