

(A) Stand Firm & United 4:1-3

We are "Brothers", "Loved", "Longed for", "his Joy", "my Crown"... of **Paul** ... → also of **Jesus Christ**!

"This is how we should **stand firm** in the Lord..."

- \rightarrow In the light of our hope: heaven & transformation
- Two Women: "You-Odious" \otimes & "Soon-Touchy" \otimes \rightarrow Learn to **agree with each** other in the Lord...
- "Euodia & Syntyche" and Paul's "Yoke-Fellow" and
 "Clement" and the rest of Paul's "Fellow-Workers"...
 → We all need Help to work together in harmony!
- \rightarrow Be willing to Give help and to Receive help...

Our names are in the **Book of Life** $// \rightarrow$ Luke 10:20 "...rejoice because your names are written in heaven"!

(B) Rejoice in the Lord & Pray 4:4-7



(B) Rejoice in the Lord & Pray 4:4-7

// 3:1 "Finally, my brothers, rejoice in the Lord!" → "Joy" → "Rejoice" → "Rejoice always" → "Again I say Rejoice"... → Is my life characterised by Joy & Rejoicing ?!

"Rejoice **in** the Lord" **because** "the Lord is near" (constant) ... not in our circumstances (which are variable)...

"Be **Gentle** to all" \rightarrow in encouraging them to rejoice, and helping them to work together in harmony.

In anything & everything: **NO** to Anxiety & **YES** to Prayer: → Our prayers to include both Thanksgiving and Requests!

God's Promise: IF we pray about all these things: \rightarrow The Peace of God will guard our hearts & minds in Christ Jesus.

(C) Think about & Follow the Best 4:8-9

Think about & Follow the Best 4:8-9

I should **Fill my Thoughts** with what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent, praiseworthy...

- → With what **words** & **images** do I feed my thought life?
- → Music? Films? DVDs? Conversations? Internet viewing?

I need to Follow the **Good Examples** in my life!

- → What we've "learned", "received", "heard", "seen" ...
- \rightarrow Be a Good **Teacher** worthy of being imitated
- \rightarrow Be a Discerning **Disciple** careful who we follow

God's Promise \rightarrow and the God of Peace will be with you...

Discovering Contentment in a World of Consumption



Paul = Grateful Contentment 4:11-13

Paul had learned to **Be Content** whatever his circumstances were: whether in Need or in Plenty...

1 Timothy 6:6-8 "godliness with **contentment** is great gain, ... But if we have food and clothing, we will be content..."

Paul knew how to enjoy life having **plenty** or having **little**...

- \rightarrow He had a **Joyful** and **Thankful** attitude of heart
- \rightarrow What is my Heart like? \rightarrow Complaining or Contented?

Paul said "I can do **everything** through **Him** who gives me strength..." → We can also live this way for the Lord!

Philippians Generous Givers 4:10, 14-20

The Philippians had Concern for the Lord's workers... They shared in Paul's troubles... → Three ways to do this: **Prayer & Support & Visits**...

From the **beginning** they shared with Paul in "Giving and Receiving" → They sent him aid "**again & again**" ...

Paul says that their **Generous Giving** was "Credited to your Account... a Fragrant Offering... an Acceptable Sacrifice... Pleasing to God..." // "make treasure in heaven" **Mat 6:20**

God's Promise: He would meet all the Philippians' needs "according to God's glorious riches in Christ Jesus" !!
